The year in review



As we look back on the past year, we are filled with gratitude for the milestones achieved and the generosity of our supporters. In 2023, our charity experienced significant growth and success, marked by new endeavors and the strengthening of long-standing partnerships.

We proudly introduced "Letters To Santa: The Holiday Gala," a new fundraising event that has quickly become a cornerstone of our annual efforts. Hosted by the gracious team at Convene at Willis Tower, the event was a spectacular success. Thanks to Convene's generous donation of the venue, catering, decor, and staffing, in addition to the support of our committed event sponsors, we were able to produce this formal, four-hour celebration without incurring event costs. The evening was illuminated by laughter and music. The gala not only celebrated our work but also raised an impressive \$138,000 for the families we serve.

In a strategic move to optimize our resources, we transitioned our beloved 24 Hour Comedy and Music Marathon to The Elysian Theater in Los Angeles. The marathon continued to capture hearts and support as it was live streamed, raising an additional \$20,000 earmarked specifically for families in Oakland.

Our enduring partnership with Onward Neighborhood House reached its 12th year, a testament to our shared commitment to community support. Through this collaboration, we identified 14 families facing severe financial hardship and extended an invitation for them to share their Christmas wishes through writing a letter to Santa. True to our mission, we responded to each letter, not only fulfilling the listed requests but also providing an abundance of thoughtful gifts. The surprise deliveries on Christmas Day included toys, warm clothing, electronics, and essential household items, ensuring each family member felt the warmth and joy of the holiday season. Furthermore, we presented each letter writer with a financial gift of \$10,000, unconditionally offered to ease their burdens and bring hope.

Our charity's achievements this past year are a reflection of the unwavering support and commitment from our donors, partners, and volunteers. Together, we have made a tangible difference in the lives of many, and we move forward with renewed energy to continue our mission of service and support in the years to come.
